

INVESTIGATOR/ANALYST

The *Ontario Immigrant Nominee Program (OINP)* is an economic immigration program run by the Ontario Ministry of Citizenship and Immigration. The program operates in partnership with the federal government through Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC) and allows Ontario to nominate skilled individuals for permanent residence in the province. The federal government has recently increased the province's allocation of nominations to 6000. The OINP is looking for several **Investigator/Analysts** to support the processing of this increased allocation to ensure that the nomination target for 2017 is met.

Your ability to use your analytical and planning skills to assess and prioritize complex applications will help you succeed in this role. You will rely on your interpersonal communication skills to provide courteous and professional customer service to applicants requesting clarification and information.

In this role, you will:

- Investigate and assess applications for the Ontario Immigrant Nominee Program to determine compliance with program criteria and objectives;
- Communicate with applicants (or their representatives) on matters relating to their application;
- Prepare reports and case notes on applications; and
- Interpret and apply relevant legislation, apply knowledge to identify suspected fraud or misrepresentation and prepare correspondence to applicants.

Qualifications:

- Post-Graduate Degree in a related field (public policy, public administration, political science, etc.) and/or 1-2 years of related work experience.
- Ability to identify, gather and assess relevant information to support decision making and identify fraud of misrepresentation of information.
- Strong written and oral communication skills with the demonstrated ability to communicate with internal and external stakeholders of all levels.
